Jail Treatment

The Minnehaha County Jail Treatment Program currently has 28 male inmates and 0 females inmates enrolled. These numbers vary slightly from time to time, depending on the current inmate population.

Furloughs

Court Ordered Furloughs, inmates who are not eligible for work release or to be housed at the CCC are routinely given furloughs by the courts to attend their work, school, Drug/Alcohol Treatment or any number of other programs. These furloughs are only authorized pursuant to an order from the courts. The current number of inmates ordered to be released on furloughs is: 6 inmates at the Jail and 15 inmates at the CCC. Through the end of the month these 21 inmates will leave and return to the facilities approximately 210 times.

24/7

The Jail also manages the 24/7 program. This program has been a great success and has grown to manage a substantial number of participants. The 24/7 participants are not in custody and are required to comply with the programs rules. There are five separate programs managed under the label of 24/7. They are:

Walk in Warrant

The Walk in Warrant program is designed to allow persons with minor outstanding warrants to turn themselves into Jail for outstanding warrants, without being arrested and processed into the Jail. The subject is required to pay the fee associated with the warrant but is not required to pay the bond listed on the warrant. Once the subject turns themselves into the Jail, they are not held but scheduled a court date typically the following day. This program has assisted in addressing approximately 105 outstanding arrest warrants per month since 2011, without the subjects being booked into jail.
